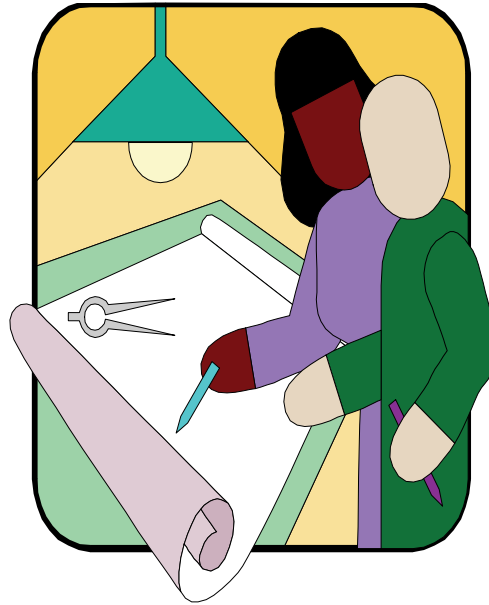


About Summer Internships

 - Exploring architecture, construction, and engineering
 - Safety instruction
 - Math practices
2. A paid summer internship @ \$10 hr for 4 weeks for students who successfully complete the two-week introductory sessions.
